Six of our campuses are in Gqeberha, in Nelson Mandela Bay, in the Eastern Cape Province. Four are in Summerstrand, one is in Bird Street in Central, and one in Missionvale. Our North and South campuses in Summerstrand are on a 840-hectare private nature reserve.

The seventh – our George Campus – is on the Garden Route, midway between Nelson Mandela Bay and Cape Town. Set at the foot of the Outeniqua Mountains, our "sustainability" campus is home to two centres of excellence – the School of Natural Resource Management and the School for Business and Social Sciences. It's where our ecological footprint meets business acumen for a sustainable future.

## Ground-breaking projects Medical School

Our programme to train MBChB graduates in Gqeberha is the first and only medical school in the western part of the province. Intentionally anchored in Missionvale to engender urban renewal and regeneration, it is set to make a tangible contribution to building capacity for accessible healthcare service delivery through its emphasis

on primary health care.

#### **Ocean Sciences**

The University has developed a range of marine and maritime education and training, research, innovation and engagement programmes to support Africa's blue economy that stretch across and within disciplines. This research modelled the factors that motivate home users to protect their home networking devices using Protection Motivation Theory as the foundation framework. Structural equation modelling was used to test the research model resulting in a final model comprising 12 constructs with 12 confirmed relations. In addition to the theoretical contribution of the formal model, the results allow for the creation of security awareness interventions that are specifically tailored to South African fibre users.

Patients increasingly rely on online information to gain a better understanding of their health. Hence, it becomes important to provide patients with the necessary tools to find the information they need. The concept of apomediation, a central concept in this research, suggests the removal of gatekeepers to information and the empowerment of patients to work towards better health outcomes. Using design science, this research developed a framework to assess to what extent social networking sites, like Facebook, facilitate apomediation, specifically, for individuals with autoimmune disease. The study makes a significant contribution to digital health in support of patient autonomy.

#### Thesis: TOWARDS PERSONAL INFORMATICS FOR ACADEMIC INTERNET SELF-REGULATORY EFFICACY—THE PAISE FRAMEWORK

The purpose of this doctoral study was to develop a framework that provides higher education institutions with guidance on how to design systems that can assist students to self-regulate their internet use - specifically, in the interest of the preservation of academic success and well-being. The Personal Informatics for Academic Internet Self-Regulatory Efficacy (PAISE) framework leverages behavioural theory previously used to explain 'internet addiction' and cognitive behavioural techniques in the form of personal informatics. The framework proposes that objective views of a student's internet behaviour are presented for reflection, so that behaviour can be adjusted accordingly. This provides a means to prevent compulsive use of the internet by facilitating reflection on internet behaviour. The PAISE framework addresses a profound and contemporary problem that is likely to persist.
