

The study set out to investigate the experiences of religious minorities in democratic societies. Using the case of Malawian Rastafarians, the study found that despite the democracy brought about by the elections of 1994, there are still misconceptions around the Rastafarian religion and that Rastafarians are still being discriminated against. The study makes a significant contribution in terms of challenging the view that, democracy equates to religious tolerance. This study makes several recommendations including the amendment of the Religious and Moral Education (RME) school curriculum, to become inclusive of other religious faiths.

In 2016 there were over 19 000 reported murders in South Africa with the Eastern Cape having the highest murder rate. Studies indicate that Port Elizabeth is hard hit by crime, adding up to 60% of all reported crimes in the province. This thesis offers an anthropological lens on police culture, court cases and legal proceedings in the city. Using the concept of 'murder-scapes', it is proposed that a 'habitus' can be discerned in the crime of murder in the city. The thesis offers a unique anthropological perspective and findings on St. Alban's Prison should be shared with Correctional Services.

Intercountry adoption as a permanent form of alternative care for orphaned and abandoned children remains a controversial issue. It is arguable that many placements of South Africa's orphaned and abandoned children within the country are not meeting the legal test of being in the "best interest of the child". This study has investigated the problematic interplay between the best-interest-of-the-child and subsidiarity principles, and the resulting application of a hierarchical approach that has been skewed against the possibility of intercountry adoption, viewing this as a measure of last resort. The study makes the case for ameliorating the negative connotations associated with intercountry adoption through strict adherence to the principles contained in the Hague Convention. It proposes a model designed to assist decision-makers to properly evaluate the best interests of the orphaned or abandoned child in determining the most appropriate form of assistance to be provided.
